Uniform Shop

Remember to get in early to buy:-

College accounts were sent home on 01 April 2018 with a due date of **FRIDAY, 11 MAY 2018**. Interest Added to LLL Savings Accounts

The interest on LLL Savings Accounts is calculated on daily balances and credited annually on 31 May. Any passbooks handed into College administration during May will be posted to LLL on your behalf. Alternatively, you may post passbooks to LLL using the Reply Paid address. When the passbooks are returned to the College in June, they will be put into the '2:30 Baskets' to take home. The interest rate on LLL Savings Accounts is currently **2.25%** per annum. In addition, LLL Savings Accounts have no fees and charges, which provide an additional benefit to LLL account holders.
