## From the Bursar.....

The fourth and final account for College Fees for 2018 went out on Friday, 12 October 2018 with a due date of **Friday, 2 November 2018**. Families are reminded that the cost of Book Packs for students in Years 1-10 for 2019 will be added to this invoice. Unless officially notified in writing, the College will assume that all students in Year 6 will progress onto our high school and will be invoiced accordingly.

Laptops for senior students and Book Packs for Preparatory and Year 11 students will be invoiced in Term 1, 2019.

Please pay your Term 4 fees promptly using internet banking, EFTPOS, credit card, cash, or cheque. Payments can be made at the office, online or through Parent Lounge. All families, including those on payment plans, are reminded that they are required to have a NIL account by 31 December 2018. Any overdue fees will be charged the \$55 administration fee.

### 2019 Fees

The 2019 Draft Budget, including the 2019 Fee Schedule, is currently being prepared ready for submission to Lutheran Education Queensland. Increases to Fees have been kept low and families will be notified of 2019 Fees on Orientation Day.
